NPSIA Research Essay

This course is designed to provide students in the joint JD/MA program with dedicated time to focus on the preparation of the Research Essay to be submitted as a requirement of the MA portion of the program. Students must enrol in CML 4203 during two terms of the year during which the Research Essay will be completed. To receive these units, your University of Ottawa co-supervisor must certify that the Research Essay is suitable for defence. Works in progress falling short of this standard will not receive credit. Students are cautioned about enrolling in CML 4203 in year 3 and failing to complete the Research Essay in that year: since no unit is awarded until the Research Essay is certified ready for defense, a failure to complete the Research Essay in year 3 will mean the student has insufficient University of Ottawa units to be promoted to year 4 of the program.
