## Option in Public Law Enrolment Form

JD students who wish to receive formal recognition of an Option must complete 18 units in the appropriate field. Students enrolled in the French Common Law Program must complete all mandatory courses in French. A minimum overall average of 6.0 in the 18 units is required and includes the mandatory course and the best results in the optional courses.

The Major Paper requirement must be completed in the area of the Option. If more than one Option is completed this requirement applies for each Option chosen. A student registered in the French Common Law Program must write the Major Paper in French in conformity with the Common Law Section's regulations.

It is possible to complete more than one Option. The units for a course which is part of more than one Option will be counted only once and cannot be cumulated from one Option to the other. The following notation will be placed on the student's course history in recognition of the successful completion of a given Option's requirements: Option in (name of Option) completed.

The form must be:

1. **Completed** by the student.\*
2. **Reviewed** and signed by the Option Coordinator.\*
3. **Submitted** to the Common Law Student Centre (FTX 237) or sent by email to: [clawacad@uottawa.ca](mailto:clawacad@uottawa.ca) before the deadline indicated in the Important Dates section of the Common Law Student Centre's website.
