General Position Description: The Department of Family Medicine is seeking a dedicated family physician and researcher with an interest in Practice-Based Research Networks. The successful candidate will be committed to advancing and promoting excellence in clinical care, education, scholarship and leadership. As a key member of the Bruyere Academic Family Health Team at the Primrose unit, you will contribute to the academic and clinical experiences of learners and patients. *Please note: Independent responsibilities and expectations will be determined in consultation with the Chair of the Department.*

Highlights of the position include:

- Training our current and future family physician leaders by supporting faculty, Family Medicine residents, and medical students in scholarly activities.
- Contributing to advancing the discipline of family medicine in a collegial and team-based learning environment.
- Managing your own practice within a fully integrated Family Health team, including nursing support, allied health providers, a Diabetes Education Team, and a Shared Mental Health Care team.
- Directing OPEN and representing the network at the Canadian Primary Care Research Consortium (CPCRC) and the Primary Care Ontario Practice-based Learning Network (POPLAR).
- Creating and operating a research program through OPEN, POPLAR, and opportunities through the CPCRN
- Encouraging the University of Ottawa, Department of Family Medicine, faculty, and residents to use OPEN and the Canadian Primary Care Information Network (CPIN) for continuous quality improvement initiatives in their clinics.

Qualified candidates must have an excellent academic record and have prior experience contributing to academic activities including scholarship, patient care, research, and leadership to enrich the Bruyere and Primrose teaching program.

Candidates will require proof of CFPC certification, valid CMPA coverage and be eligible for licensure in Ontario. Physicians in this role must have academic standing at Assistant Professor or above. The position will be full time academic, consisting of 0.4 FTE clinical and 0.6 FTE research activities (which includes 0.2 FTE as the Director of OPEN).
